

# Save Our Sheds Petition – July 29, 2011

It has been brought to my attention that the only remaining structures representing 150 years of granite quarry operations at 61 quarrying sites will be lost if the current council directive is carried out.

I respectfully request that members of the Rocklin City Council reconsider and rescind the directive that would result in disassembly and/or demolition of the Big Gun Monument and Cutting Sheds at this time and that the City allow one year for Community input regarding the fate of these Heritage Structures.
